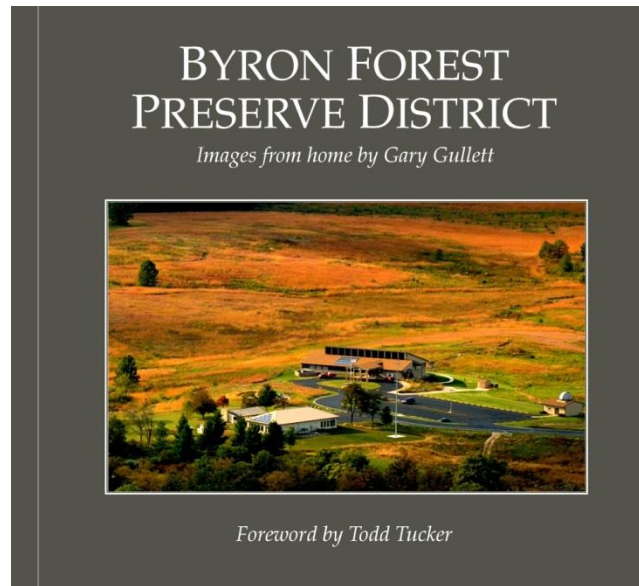


Book Release

The Byron Forest Preserve District is pleased to announce a new Konza Press photo book featuring the Byron Forest Preserve from wildlife photographer and Byron native, Gary Gullett.

The book is the culmination of a three year project, and includes 40 stunning full color photographs that illustrate wildlife and landscape images from the Forest Preserve District.

Gary's work appears in numerous publications and private collections. Many of the images in this book are on permanent display at the Jarrett Prairie Center or the PrairieView Golf Club, both located at the Byron Forest Preserve.

Pre-ordered books will be mailed or can be picked up at the Preserve at that time. They will also be available after that date for \$15 from the Byron Forest Preserve District and Severson Dells Nature Center.

With over 2,000 acres of rolling prairie and woodlands in northern Illinois' Ogle County, the Byron Forest Preserve District continues to fulfill its three part mission: Preservation, Education, and Recreation.

For more than 30 years, the district has been devoted to acquiring and managing natural areas to increase biodiversity, and to conserve the habitat and species of the region. Open year around, the district includes walking trails, picnic shelters, a playground, equine prairie, golf course, educational center, museum and observatory.
